The Washington Area Humane Society thanks you for supporting our shelter. We care about the future of your animals and we want them to share a happy healthy life with you.

Our Pet Care Outpatient Clinic opened in 1998 to help in the management of simple routine pet care issues. That includes vaccinations, parasite and flea prevention, and fecal tests as indicated on the following page. We see clients only on scheduled clinic days at out facility. An appointment is required.

Annual membership fee is \$30 for your first animal and only \$15 for each additional animal in the household. This entitles your pet(s) to all office visits during the year. You will only be charged for the vaccinations, medicines, fecal work, etc that your pet receives which are offered at a reduced rate. There will be no charge for the actual office visit. Our price schedule for medicines and services is greatly discounted. A current schedule is included on page 2.

The clinic is an **Out Patient Clinic** and we urge our members to also have a private veterinarian for your pets' emergencies and other healthcare needs.

By becoming a member of our Pet Care Outpatient Clinic, you will also be helping our orphaned animals. Profits from the clinic will be used to care for the thousands of unwanted animals that spend time in our shelter yearly.
